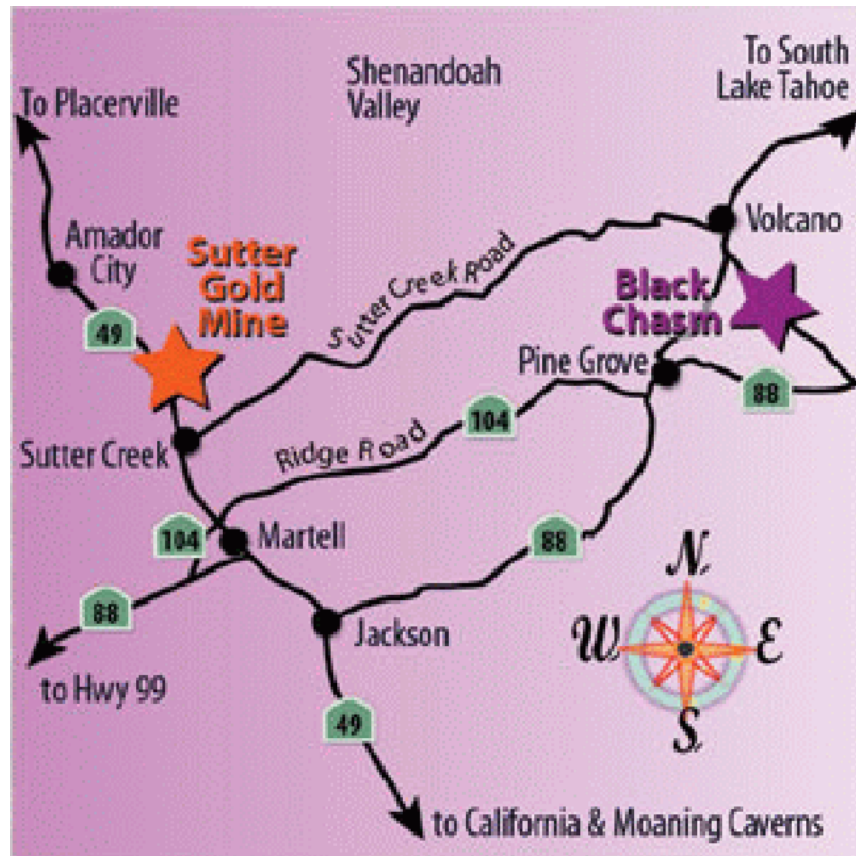


# MAP TO BLACK CHASM CAVERN

## Directions: Traveling *South* on Highway 49

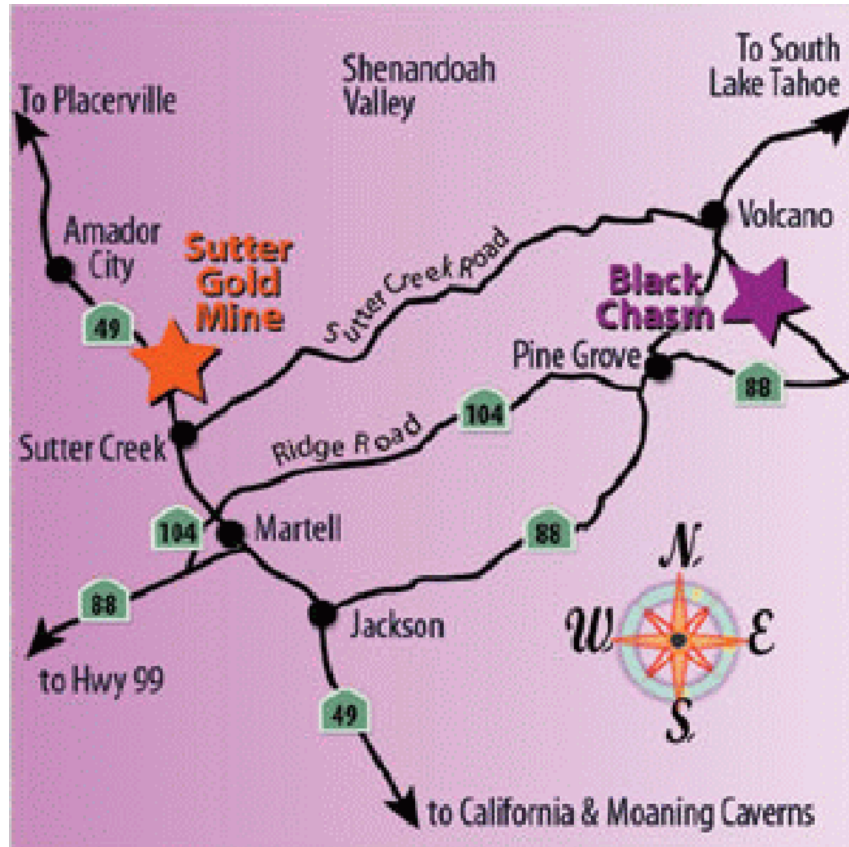
- ◆ Follow Highway 49 south to Jackson.
- ◆ At the traffic light at the intersection of Highway 49 and Highway 88, turn left onto Highway 88 and travel east to Pine Grove.
- ◆ Make a left turn toward Volcano on Pine Grove-Volcano Road (**follow the sign**) and continue two and a half miles to the bottom of the steep hill.
- ◆ Make a sharp right turn onto Pioneer-Volcano Road (**follow the sign**) and continue about 1500 feet.
- ◆ Turn right at the Black Chasm National Landmark entrance and drive to the parking lot.

## Directions: Traveling *North* on Highway 49

- ◆ Follow Highway 49 north to Jackson.
- ◆ At the traffic light at the intersection of Highway 49 and Highway 88, turn right onto Highway 88 and travel east to Pine Grove.
- ◆ Make a left turn toward Volcano on Pine Grove-Volcano Road (**follow the sign**) and continue two and a half miles to the bottom of the steep hill.
- ◆ Make a sharp right turn onto Pioneer-Volcano Road (**follow the sign**) and continue about 1500 feet.
- ◆ Turn right at the Black Chasm National Landmark entrance and drive to the parking lot.

# MAP TO SUTTER GOLD MINE

## **Directions: Traveling South on Highway 49**

- ◆ Follow Highway 49 south toward Sutter Creek
- ◆ About 2 miles south of Drytown, take the left turn lane with the sign that says "Amador City & Sutter Creek on to **OLD Highway 49** - **DO NOT TAKE THE NEW HIGHWAY 49 BY PASS.**
- ◆ Follow OLD Highway 49 through the historic town of Amador City.
- ◆ Continue about 0.5 miles south of Amador City and turn left into the entrance to Sutter Gold Mine and park in the parking lot

## **Directions: Traveling North on Highway 49**

- ◆ Follow Highway 49 north toward Sutter Creek
- ◆ About 0.5 miles north of the intersection of Highway 49 and Ridge Road, There is a signal light. Turn right onto the **OLD Highway 49** - **DO NOT TAKE THE NEW HIGHWAY 49 BY PASS.**
- ◆ Travel north on Old Highway 49 through the historic town of Sutter Creek.
- ◆ Continue about 1 mile north of the town and turn right into the entrance to Sutter Gold Mine and park in the parking lot
